



On-campus parking for employees and students at Ivy Tech North Central (Elkhart County, South Bend, and Warsaw) campuses and sites

Ivy Tech North Central has instituted a system of annual parking hang tags for all students, faculty and staff wishing to park in lots on the South Bend, Elkhart County and Warsaw campuses, as well as on other sites owned or leased by the region.

Starting July 1, 2014 parking passes will be available free of charge.

Parking hang tags can be obtained at the Bursar Office. It is recommended that tags are obtained July 1. Current tags expire July 31.

To provide a more secure campus environment, all students, faculty and staff are required to obtain and display an Ivy Tech parking hang tag in their vehicle if they park on the South Bend, Elkhart County or Warsaw campuses or sites.

Parking at Ivy Tech South Bend

The west parking lot near the portable classrooms is general parking for students, faculty and staff. Parking in this lot is on a first come, first served basis. Visitor and assigned parking on the north side of the building is clearly marked.

The parking lot at the far southeast corner of the South Bend campus parking lot is a faculty and staff only parking lot.

The large parking lot located on the east side of the campus/Fellows St. is a student lot also available to faculty and staff, but there are no rows reserved for employees.

The parking lot located on the south side of campus is a student lot also available to faculty and staff, but there are no rows reserved for employees.

Do not park in the shipping/receiving/Automotive Technology area which is clearly marked.

Look for the signage in our lots that will help you find where to park and check for updates on Campus Connect.

Frequently Asked Questions

Am I required to obtain a parking hang tag? No. You may park off-campus without an Ivy Tech parking hang tag. However, if you choose to park on campus, you are required to obtain and display a parking hang tag.

Visitor parking is available, but it is not intended for regional students or employees. Vehicles belonging to students or employees parked in visitor parking may be towed.

How do I obtain my parking tag? Parking tags may be obtained in the South Bend, Elkhart County and Warsaw Bursar Offices.

Does obtaining a parking hang tag guarantee me a parking space on campus? Although every effort will be made to ensure that only vehicles with current hang tags are utilizing campus parking spaces, obtaining a parking hang tag does not guarantee the availability of a parking space.

What College sites are included in the parking hang tag requirement? Owned and leased facilities included in the parking hang tag requirement are:

Campuses in South Bend, Elkhart County and Warsaw
Lung Instructional Center (Elkhart County)
Ivy Tech on Sample Street building (South Bend)
Respiratory Care program site
Orthopedic and Advanced Manufacturing Training Center (Warsaw)
Ivy Tech Potentials Unlimited Learning Lab (Elkhart County)
Other sites the region may purchase or lease in the future

Owned and leased sites do not include sites where outreach classes may be held, such as high schools, career centers, and WorkOne sites.

I teach/take classes at more than one campus in the region. How many hang tags do I need to obtain? Only one hang tag needs to be obtained at any of the Bursar Offices in the region.

I teach/take Ivy Tech classes only at an outreach site (such as a WorkOne site, career center, or high school). Do I need a parking tag to park in those lots? No, not at this time. However, if you frequently visit one of the regional campuses or College-owned or leased facilities for other business and want to park on-campus, you will need to obtain and display a parking tag.
