ABOUT ADVANTAGE SHELBY COUNTY

- Advantage Shelby County is a two-year college scholarship program specifically aimed at raising educational attainment and workforce readiness in Shelby County
- Partnership between the City of Shelbyville, Shelby County, and Ivy Tech Community College
- Provides gap scholarship funding to Shelby County Students to pay tuition costs not covered by state, federal or institutional aid
- In exchange for local support, students agree to perform 10 hours of community service per semester or fulfill a program work requirement with a Shelby County company
- Available to students graduating from a Shelby County high school or completing home school, HSE, or attending the Excel Center while residing in the county (before they turn 19)

• Educate students in Shelby County to retain them in Shelby County

Complete 10 hours of volunteer community service

ELIGIBILITY

- Students must maintain satisfactory academic progress
- Must be a graduate of a Shelby County High School beginning with the class of 2016 (or complete a Shelby County, IN home school program, or obtain a high school equivalency (HSE) diploma (prior to reaching nineteen (19) years of age) within the Shelby County, IN community)
- Have a final high school GPA of 2.0 or above
- Be considered college ready as determined by Ivy Tech Placement Standards at www.ivytech.edu/assessment
- Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen (DACA status is not classified as an eligible non-citizen)
- Enroll full-time in a qualifying program
- Pledge to meet all program requirements and deadlines

MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

- Comply with Advantage Shelby County Pledge
- Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Complete annual scholarship renewal application by March 10th
- Complete FAFSA by April 15th of each year
- Submit verification of community service each semester
- Not be convicted of use of illegal drugs or a criminal act
- Complete program within the allotted time frame
