There's no reason to be nervous about your first term at Ivy Tech Community College. We're here to help you every step of the way. You can always touch base with your local [Enrollment Center](#) to make sure you're ready for classes.

Whether you're taking courses online, virtually, or in-person, you'll be able to get to know your peers. Our average class size is about 12 students, so your instructors have the time and resources to help students on an individual basis.

Familiarize yourself with the course formats you'll have the option of taking:

- **Traditional** classes are exactly what you might expect. In this format, the instructor and students gather in an on-campus classroom at a scheduled time.



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- **Online** classes are where there is no scheduled class meeting time but students do have plenty of opportunities to interact with their instructor through IvyLearn. Course assignments will be assigned and completed through your IvyLearn class page on a weekly (or regular) basis.
- **Virtual** classes are similar to traditional classes but instead of meeting in the classroom you meet in a live video call at a scheduled time.
- **Blended** classes mix the traditional course format with virtual or online formats. There is a scheduled class time, but you'll spend some days in the classroom, and some days in an online learning space.
- **Learn Anywhere** courses are taught in the classroom at a scheduled time but can also be accessed in a virtual format. Attendance at each class session is mandatory but students have the choice of whether they would like to attend in person or virtually on a week-to-week basis.

Subject: Become familiar with IvyLearn

IvyLearn is Ivy Tech's online learning platform powered by Canvas. You can get to IvyLearn through the [MyIvy student portal](#). To sign into your account, use your Ivy Tech email address as your username and your Ivy Tech password.

Once you log in to [IvyLearn](#), you will see a Dashboard. On the left are navigation links to access features listed below:

1. **Account:** You can edit your profile, change your settings, set notifications, access and upload files, and logout from here.
2. **Dashboard:** The Dashboard shows past and present courses, upcoming assignments, and feedback from instructors.
3. **Courses:** This link will list the same courses as the Dashboard. Clicking on All Courses will allow you to select which courses appear on the Dashboard. Click on the star to add or remove a course.
4. **Calendar:** The Calendar shows due dates and other important events that some instructors have added. You can filter the Calendar to see all classes or a specific course.
5. **Inbox:** You can use the inbox to send and receive messages within Canvas. An icon will show up when you have unread messages.
6. **Studio:** You can view and upload videos in the Studio tab, as well as interact with videos uploaded by your instructor and other students.



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7. **Resources:** Here, you can find shortcuts to helpful resources like Ivy+ Career Link, the Helpdesk, library services, the Student Resource Center, and more.

It's important to log in to IvyLearn prior to the start of the upcoming term. Classes open in IvyLearn two days before the start of class, so log in early to familiarize yourself with the platform and give yourself time to reach out if you have any questions. And don't worry, you've got this!
