2024-2025 Concurrent Enrollment

During the 2024-2025 academic year, high schools enrolled 98,507 students in Ivy Tech dual credit programming to date. These partnerships have led to the registration of 723,094 college credits, resulting in \$122,976,597 in savings for students and their families. By offering strategic and intentional college in high school programming, high school students have earned 1,279 post-secondary credentials so far this year with many more completions anticipated at the conclusion of the Spring 2025 semester.

National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Programs (NACEP) Reaffirmation

The College is entering the second half of its self-study year as it begins the process of reaffirming its NACEP dual credit accreditation. The upcoming academic year, 2025-2026, will be the data and evidence collection year. The following academic year, 2026-2027, the College will be reviewed by a peer review team and NACEP will vote on the College's accreditation status. For those who do not know, Ivy Tech is the largest NACEP accredited institution in the nation (by a factor of over three)!

One area that has been identified through the self-study process as a point of emphasis for next year is new course onboarding. The accreditation standard requires 100% onboarding of dual credit instructors before the start of term before a new course can be taught by an instructor. A revised onboarding process for our internal and external stakeholders will be rolled out late in February following the spring registration period to ensure the College continues to meet this standard. In addition, the 2025-2026 deadlines and academic year calendar will be forthcoming after the current spring registration period ends.
